Tournament Notes:

1. Please ensure you have read the Bordenball Rules and your team is prepared.

3. Play-offs

- a. Everyone will make the playoffs
- b. You will play teams from your pool

4. In the event of a tie in pool play the following steps will be used:

Two teams tied:

- a) The team with the better goals for vs goal against ratio will be ranked higher.
- b) If teams are tied then a flip of the coin will be used.

Three + Teams tied:

- a) Teams will be ranked by goals for vs goal against ratio amongst the tied teams.
- b) If there are still 2 tied teams you will refer to the above format.
- c) If 3 teams are tied then draw will take place.
- d) If two teams are tied then a flip of the coin will be used.

5. When you arrive please follow directions on staking out a spot in where your school will leave their outdoor clothing etc... this will be your team meeting place. When your team is not playing this is where they should be.
